## **The Location**

Park City is located in the beautiful Wasatch Mountains @ 35 miles from **Salt Lake International Airport**. Transportation is available via shuttles and private vehicle services, in addition to rental car options.

A historic silver mining town, Park City was incorporated as a city in 1884. Over the years, Park City has reserved its old-time charm and the town's history is still apparent, particularly on Main Street, often referred to as Old Town Park City. On Main Street, you will find an exciting mix of nightlife, shopping and art galleries.



## **The Resort**



Stein Eriksen Lodge is only a few minutes from Old Town and its associated attractions, along with many other interesting historic and engaging places. It is the only 5-star, 5-diamond resort in Park City. It features every amenity you'll need, including a world-class spa, 24-hour room service, a Fitness Center and Wellness Studio, complimentary Wireless Internet and laundry and dry cleaning services
